- Focus on evaluation of DSM2v7 performance for historical simulations
 - Flow, stage and salinity
 - Simulation period to be determined
 - Assess field data availability and quality
 - Determine what has changed since last calibration
 - Define performance metrics
 - Evaluate model performance
 - Document findings
- Determine if recalibration is warranted
