

# Notice of Release of Proposition 84 Delta, San Joaquin River, and Sacramento River Water Quality Final PSP Group II Grants

## **Introduction:**

With the November 2006 passage of Proposition 84 (the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006), the Department of Water Resources (DWR) gained \$130 million in grant funding to improve Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta water quality. DWR is preparing to make available \$36.6 million of the funding for eligible projects (defined as Group II projects) that meet the intent of Section 75029(c) of the California Water Code (CWC). The final Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP) for Group II (Franks Tract and Other Delta Region Projects) grants was released on February 6, 2015. Funding is planned for grant projects that meet the following project eligibility criteria:

- *Local agencies with projects at Franks Tract and other locations in the Delta that will reduce salinity or other pollutants at agricultural and drinking water intakes.*
